The role of Signalling Installer is defined as installing and wiring signalling equipment, using test equipment, and carrying out installation integrity checks, such as wire count and continuity checks.

Signalling Maintainers will be capable of maintaining, fault finding & rectifying signalling systems and equipment, completing integrity checks on works, instigating testing and identifying where independence of testing is required.

Tester: the primary purpose of this role is the undertaking of signalling functional testing activities on various signalling equipment currently in use on the underground and main line rail networks. You will be required to ensure correct testing practices adhered to. Your responsibility to ensure all preparation and testing documentation is inline with both the company and client standards. You will be required to liaise with testing team leaders, testing managers and testing and commissioning team members.

Required Experience

For this role you will be required to have an appropriate IRSE licence as well as previous experience on mainline rail and/or London underground. You must be able to demonstrate good communication.

The ideal candidate will have to be reliable, flexible, punctual, and must also hold a Valid Full UK Driving Licence.
